

SUBJECT: Day Service Center for the Homeless - Update

Since our last update to Council on October 20, 2017, regarding use of the former U.S. Marine Corps Reserve Center at 7401 Warwick Boulevard as a Day Service Center for the homeless, staff has continued to engage our federal partners to fulfill the requirements of the Notice of Surplus Determination Homeless Suitability and Availability under the U.S. Health and Human Services (HHS).

On November 3, 2017, we were informed by HHS that our most recent application for transfer of the U.S. Marine Corps Reserve Center to the City by quitclaim deed was approved. While we have not received the deed for transfer of the property, the U.S. General Services Administration has advised staff that execution of the deed is expected in January 2018.

Assistant City Manager Alan Archer will provide an update and outline the next steps to advance the Day Service Center at our next Work Session on January 9, 2018.
