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### Agreement in Lieu of an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan

In consideration of not being required to prepare and submit an erosion and sediment control plan for this construction, I agree to comply with any reasonable erosion and sediment control requirements deemed necessary by the Director of Engineering. Such requirements shall be based on the conservation standards contained in the latest Virginia erosion and sediment control laws and regulations and shall represent the minimum practices necessary to provide adequate control of erosion and sedimentation on or resulting from this project. The attached typical uses of erosion and sediment (E/S) controls shall be utilized both on and off the site.

As a minimum:

- 1) All denuded areas on the lot shall be stabilized within seven (7) days of final grading with permanent vegetation or a protective ground cover suitable for the time of the year.
- 2) Steps shall be taken to prevent the off-site tracking of dirt, mud, or debris.
- 3) Installation of silt fences, inlet protection (IP), and straw barriers shall be as necessary to protect existing drainage ways, storm sewer systems, and adjacent property.

In the event the above-noted minimum requirements do not achieve the desired erosion and sediment control, I further agree to make the necessary reasonable changes to my control devices to achieve the desired level of control as required by the Director of Engineering.

I further understand that failure to comply with such requirements could result in a citation for violation of the City of Newport News code and the stoppage of all land-disturbing activity on the site.
