



Wipes and debris build up in a pump that is used to pump wastewater. This can cause damage to the pump.



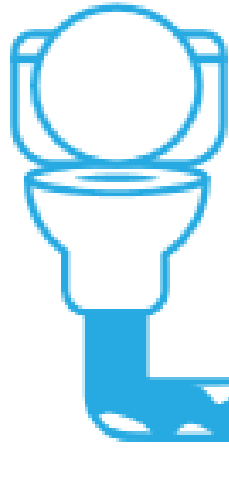
The process of removing the wipes is called de-ragging the pump. The pumps must be disassembled for cleaning. Some pumps in the City require de-ragging many times a year.



This shows a partial remove of the blockage from the pumps interior.



This shows the pump cleared of the blockage. This type of blockage causes excessive wear and tear on the pump and can shorten the life of the pump; requiring more frequent replacement.
