

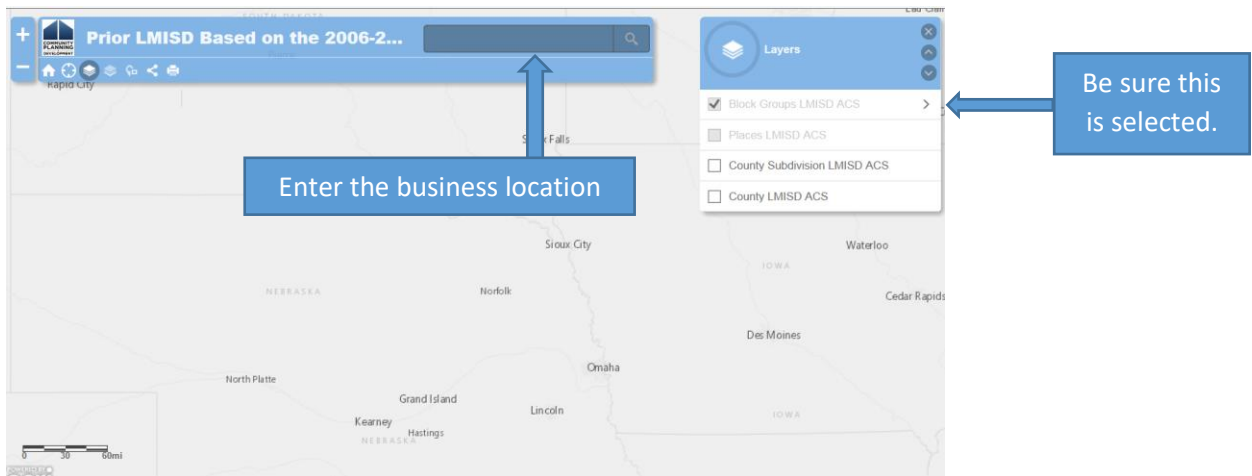
## Newport News Micro-Enterprise Grant Program Determining if a Business is Located in a Low to Moderate Income (LMI) Area

In order to qualify for the Micro Enterprise Grant, the business owners must be low to moderate income (see attached “LMI Chart”) or the business must be located in a low to moderate income area at the time of application. If the business is not located in a low to moderate income area, you must complete the Income Verification Form for each business owner. To determine if your business is located in a low to moderate income area follow the instructions provided below.

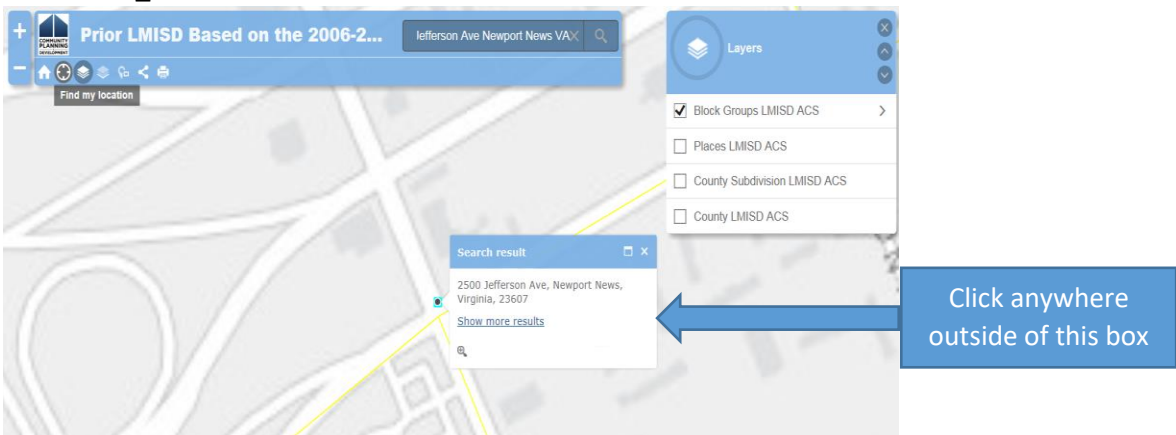
- 1.) Copy or type this link into your browser search box to visit the HUD maps website.

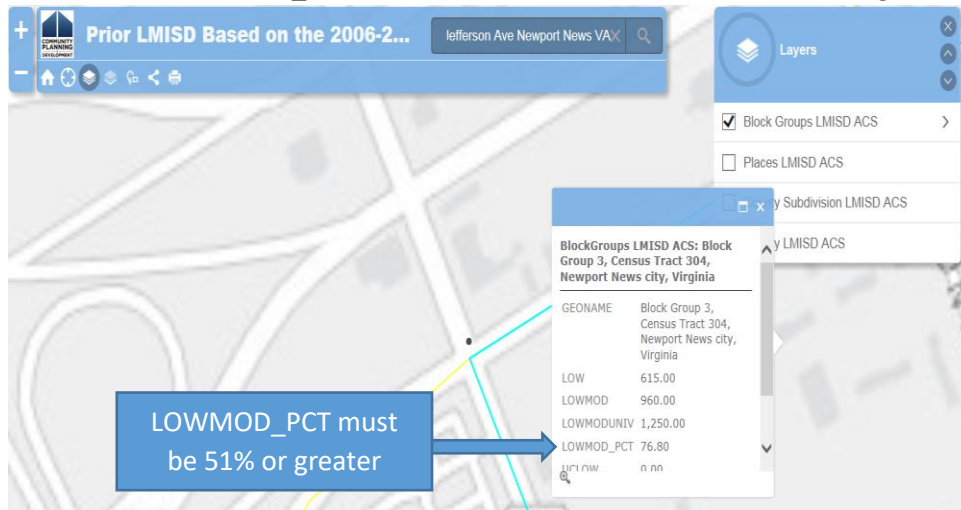
- 2.) Enter the business location and make sure the “Block Groups LMISD ACS” is selected.



- 3.) Once the Search Results box appears, you can click outside of this box to get the “LOWMOD\_PCT”



4.) Look for the "LOWMOD\_PCT". This number must be above 51% to be eligible.
