**RESOLUTION IN MEMORIAM**

**TROOPER CHAD P. DERMYER**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Newport News, Virginia, records with deep and profound sadness the tragic and untimely death of Virginia State Police Trooper Chad P. Dermeyer on March 31, 2016, as the result of gun shot wounds received in the line-of-duty; and

WHEREAS, a native of Jackson, Michigan, Chad P. Dermeyer served as an officer with the Newport News Police Department from 2003 until 2007, before returning to Michigan to serve with the Jackson, Michigan Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Chad P. Dermeyer returned to the Commonwealth of Virginia and graduated from the Virginia State Police Academy in November of 2014; and

WHEREAS, Chad P. Dermeyer's original patrol assignment with the State Police was to the Chesapeake Division's Area 46 Office, encompassing the cities of Newport News and Hampton. He was recently transferred to the State Police Counter-Terrorism and Criminal Interdiction Unit; and

WHEREAS, Chad P. Dermeyer served his country, spending four years as a member of the U.S. Marine Corps; and

WHEREAS, Chad P. Dermeyer was an outstanding law enforcement officer, and was recognized as "Officer of the Month" on no less than five occasions during his tenure with the Newport News Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Chad P. Dermeyer is survived by his wife, Michelle P. Dermeyer; his son, Phillip T. Dermeyer; and his daughter, Page M. Dermeyer; along with numerous other relatives and close friends; and

WHEREAS, Chad P. Dermeyer was a dedicated law enforcement officer and well-regarded member of the Newport News police department family whose years of service in defending his community, state and country this Council wishes to recognize and honor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Newport News, Virginia:

1. That it hereby recognizes all that Chad P. Dermeyer has done to serve the City of Newport News and the Commonwealth of Virginia and honors him for his service to this community.

2. That it is ordered that the City Clerk shall record this resolution in the minutes of this body and that a copy be presented to the family of the late Chad P. Dermeyer.

3. That this resolution shall be in effect on and after the date of its adoption, April 12, 2016.
